WRANGLERS		N/A	SEASON IN REVIEW The Wranglers wrap up year four with a record of 24-29-2-4 with 54 points, finishing in 8 th place in the South Division – missing the playoffs for the second time in franchise history and the first since the club's inaugural season in 2021-22. The 2024-25 campaign featured many highs and lows, with the Wranglers starting out 6-0, matching a franchise best to start a season, followed by a coaching change 20 games into the year. Amarillo's hot start was backstopped by its goaltending – which began to waver in November and faltered in December and January. The team struggled to score for most of the season, finishing as the third lowest scoring team in the South. Amarillo also saw a lot of turnover, rostering 55 players over the course of the season. Despite all this, the Wranglers were able to overcome adversity going 6-2-1-1 in their final 10 games finishing just 4 points back of the final playoff spot, having been eliminated with just three games left on the schedule. Amarillo's future looks bright with 16 of the 23 players on the roster on 4/6 being eligible to return for 2025-26. LAST TIME OUT The Wranglers defeated the Grit 5-4 in overtime on Sunday in the final game of the season. Amarillo scored three goals in the first period from Miller, Peipinen, and Rassega while Colorado got goals from Smith and Gleasman as Amarillo led 3-2 after one. There was no scoring in the second period. The scoring resumed in the third period with Colorado's Johnson tying the game at 3-3. Saterdalen gave Amarillo the lead with 2:15 to go, but Poirier tied it at 4-4 with 5.6 left in regulation. Saterdalen scored the OT winner 20 seconds into overtime to give Amarillo the 5-4 win, as the Schoephoerster stopped 28/32 in the win. Amarillo went 0/1 on the PP and 2/3 on the PK. SATERDALEN & GIRARD EARN SOUTH DIVISION HONORS Cole Saterdalen (4g, 3a in 3gp) and Charles-Antoine Girard (1 SO, .5 GAA, .976 SV%, 2-0 Rec, 41/42) both earned South Division 2 nd and 3 rd Star honors for their efforts in the final weekend of the regular season. Both Girard (19) and Saterdalen (19) are eligible to return for the 2025-26 season.

STORYLINES

The Story so Far

With the Wranglers' sweeps in Oklahoma and Colorado, plus wins at the Showcase against Maryland and New Hampshire, Amarillo improved to 6-0 on the season. In all four seasons of the Wranglers' existence, the team has started off the season with a record of at least 2-0. Amarillo matched their best start from 2022-23 in 24-25, going 6-0 to open the campaign before falling to the Fairbanks Ice Dogs 4-2 at the NAHL Showcase.

The Wranglers finished up a historic 11-game road trip to open the season in Shreveport. It was the longest road trip in Wranglers franchise history, spanning 36 days in 5 different cities, spanning an impressive 4,735 miles in travel. Amarillo went 7-3-0-1 on the road to open the season, proving that they are a force to be reckoned with on the road.

The Wranglers first 20 games could be broken up into two halves, showcasing the team's hot start and their recent cold stretch. In their first 10 games the Wranglers were 6-3-0-1, averaging 2.4 GF and 2.4 GA, with 26.7 SF/G and 31.1 SF/G. In their last 10 the Wranglers have gone 3-6-0-1 averaging 2.7 GF and 4.7 GA with 33 SF/G and 33.9 SF/G.

Analytically it can be determined that recently the Wranglers scoring is actually up a touch and they are shooting the puck on net considerably more than when they had their hot start. This data doesn't tell us the *quality* of the shots but what we can gather is that while the average shots on goal against are up by a slight margin, the goals against per game is astronomically higher going from a 2.4 GA/G to a 4.7 GA/G. This is likely due to two causes – the Wranglers high level of goaltending was unsustainable AND/OR the quality of shots given up has increased causing more goals against. In short, the offense is functioning at about the same level, while the defense and goaltending have taken a step back in the last 10 games.

Amarillo was 13-14-0-3 at the midway mark and sat in the final playoff spot in the South Division with 29 points on the year. Amarillo is 3-4-0-1 under new head coach Corey Wogtech, and the offense has come alive under his tenure averaging 3.13 goals per game 8 games into his tenure, with the power play contributing 8 goals in that span.

Amarillo Winners in Close Games Last Season

When it came down to winning close games, the Wranglers proved they can squeeze out wins in tight situations. In 2023-24, the Wranglers were 22-8-5-2 in games decided by one or two goals. Only ten of the Wranglers thirty-two wins came by a 3+ goal margin. Amarillo was 9-6 in overtime and 3-2 in the shootout.

Jacobson Accomplishes Rare Feat

Carl Jacobson recorded 4 assists in 12/21's 6-3 win over Colorado, becoming the first Wrangler to record three assists in a single game this season. He is the fourth Wrangler to record three points in the same game.

A New Head Coach

On November 29, 2024, the Wranglers announced that they had parted ways with former Head Coach Taylor Harnett and had named Corey Wogtech the team's new Head Coach.

Wogtech brings a wealth of experience playing and coaching hockey at various levels, including the NAHL, to the Texas Panhandle. As a goaltender, he attended and played college hockey at the College of St. Scholastica before turning pro in 2005. He spent several years playing in the Southern Professional Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and the International Hockey League before his retirement from playing hockey after a season in Europe in 2009.

Following his playing career, Wogtech became a coach with the NAHL's St. Louis Bandits in 2009 as a Goaltending Coach. The next season he accepted a position with the University of Nebraska-Omaha (UNO) as a Goaltending Coach where under Dean Blais, helped turn UNO into a top 10 program in the country. From 2012 to 2014 Wogtech worked with the Indiana Ice of the USHL, where he and Head Coach Jeff Brown secured a Clark Cup Championship in 2014. After capturing the Clark Cup in Indiana, Wogtech joined the USHL's Bloomington Thunder where he worked under current Bowling Green Head Coach Dennis Williams for three seasons. After two seasons with the Central Illinois Flying Aces, Wogtech returned to college hockey in 2020 where under the direction of David Carle, was an integral part of keeping the University of Denver a top 10 program in the country and an NCAA powerhouse.

Through his playing and coaching career, Wogtech has played an intricate role with teams in the NAHL, USHL, and NCAA D1, helping them become annual contenders and top programs in the USA. He knows what it takes to win and how to win, and will bring his knowledge and experience to the Wranglers, who in year four of the franchise's existence, are looking to capture their first Robertson Cup Championship.

Wranglers President of Hockey Operations & GM Harry Mahood enters his second year as President of Hockey Ops and fourth with the Wranglers. He was the first Head Coach in Wranglers history, posting a record of 61-52-3-4 including a 9-game winning streak in the 22-23 season that helped the Wranglers make the postseason for the first time.

Morley Phillips Named 5th Captain in Franchise History

On November 27, 2024, the Wranglers announced that Morley Phillips had been named the 5th captain in franchise history. He joins a prestigious and exclusive group of players who have served as the team's captain, featuring Michael Spinner (2021-22), Jayden Jensen (2021-22), Chase Davis (2022-23), and Ben Ivey (2023-24).

In his second year with the club, Phillips has become a leader on and off the ice for the Wranglers. Morley was acquired in a trade from the Maryland Black Bears early in the 2023-24 season and at the time of the announcement, has played in 58 games with the Wranglers, tallying 7 goals and 13 assists with the club. He is known for his physical presence, his wicked shot, and his willingness to stick up for his teammates, and has continued to grow his game and emerge as a leader since his first shift in Amarillo.

Year Four of the Wranglers

The Wranglers are entering year four as an organization and have improved upon their point total from the previous year every season they've been in the NAHL – including back to back appearances in the Robertson Cup Playoffs in 2023 and 2024.

New Kids on the Block

The Wranglers added a pair of players with previous NAHL experience to the roster ahead of their matchup with the New Mexico Ice Wolves. Amarillo added forward Mason Lupo and defenseman Anthony White to their lineup, both formerly with the Danbury Hat Tricks. Lupo joins Amarillo after scoring 3g, 4a, in 27gp with Danbury this season, while White has 1g, 5a in 27gp this season (21 with Danbury, 6 with Elmira). Both have over 70+ games of NAHL experience, with Lupo having 19pts in 74 career NAHL games all with the Hat Tricks, and White having 11pts in 73 career games with the Hat Tricks and Aviators.

Prior to their weekend series in El Paso, the Wranglers added former Mountain Kings forward Kirill Evstigneev, former Hat Tricks forward Ty Izadi, former Wings forward Cole Saterdalen, former Hat Tricks defenseman Jean-Sebastien Pack, and former Jr. Blues goaltender Matt Schoephoerster.

Evstigneev scored 1 goal and 3 assists in 16 games with the Mountain Kings this season.

In 37 games with Danbury, Izadi scored 4 goals and 8 assists and had a +6 rating.

Pack started the season with the Springfield Jr. Blues, scoring 1 goal and 1 assist with a +1 rating in 3 games before playing in 18 games with the Hat Tricks, scoring 1 goal and 1 assists with a -2 rating.

Cole Saterdalen joins the Wranglers via a trade with the Aberdeen Wings. Having started his NAHL career in Aberdeen to begin the 24-25 season, Saterdalen recorded 3 goals and 8 assists for 11 points in 32 games with the Wings prior to coming to Amarillo.

Schoephoerster joins the Wranglers having spent the first 2/3 of the season with the Springfield Jr. Blues. With the Jr. Blues, he posted a record of 6-5-1 in 13 appearances, with a 2.87 GAA and a .910 SV%

Jean-Sebastien Pack Commits to Augsburg University

Defenseman JS Pack has announced his commitment to play NCAA DIII hockey for Augsburg University. In eight games with the Wranglers, Pack has 2 assists and a +2 rating with the club, giving them a big boost defensively. He then began the 2024-25 season in the NAHL with the Springfield Jr. Blues, where he scored 1 goal and 1 assist in 3 games before joining the Hat Tricks, where he scored 1 goal and 2 assists in 18 games.

Morley Phillips Commits to SUNY Cortland

Captain Morley Phillips has announced his commitment to play NCAA DIII hockey for SUNY Cortland. In 80 games with the Wranglers, Phillips has notched 16 goals and 24 assists for 40 points. This year he was named the 5th captain in franchise history, leading the team in goals, assists, and points at the time of the announcement.

Aleslov Named Alternate Captain

Last Wednesday it was announced that Alexander Aleslöv had been named an Alternate Captain. In 51 games with the Wranglers, Aleslöv has scored 10 goals and 13 assists for 23 points and a +2 rating. Alex is coming off of a massive weekend in Colorado where he scored 3 goals and 1 assist in two games vs the Grit. He is tied for the team lead in multi-point games with 4, and multi-goal games with 2. He has also been clutch for the Wranglers in close games with three game winning goals, tying him with Cole Saterdalen for the team lead. Aleslöv also leads the team in power play assists with 4.
